
Disaster Event – Central Western Queensland Heavy Rainfall and Flooding, 2 – 4 February 2016



Event and Timing -

A deep trough extending across central western Queensland caused heavy rainfall and flooding in the shires of Boulia and Cloncurry on 2 – 4 February 2016.

Assistance Activated -

The Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services activated the Commonwealth/State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).


NDRRA Relief Measures Activated -

"Communities within the Boulia and Cloncurry shires affected by heavy rainfall and flooding, 2 – 4 February 2016"


